

CPS Bicycle Regulations

It is important that you lock/fasten your bike only in designated areas and to bikeracks.

- Illegally parked bikes obstruct walkways and present serious hazards for people who use wheelchairs, canes, walkers, or who have mobility or visual difficulties. Please do not park your bike in line of travel to stairs, ramps, or doorways. Bikes impeding wheelchair access or pedestrian traffic may be impounded.
- Do not lock/fasten a bike to a tree, shrub do to potential damage.
- Bikes are not allowed in the building. At CRLS and King/PAUS staff can utilize the parking garage. Students are not allowed to utilize the staff garage.
- Do not lock/ fasten a bike to lamp poles, handrails, bus shelters, school signs, trash receptacles, or fences or benches. Against or fastened to water, gas pipes, or any electrical fixture or emergency devise.
- Bicycles deemed abandoned or derelict may be impounded.

The Department of Safety and Security will not be held liable for securing devices (locks) which are damaged during impoundment. Contact the Department of Safety and Security if you have any policy related questions or to verify your bike has been impounded.
